

Choose your environment

What type of environment are you looking for? E.g., agency, non-profit, entertainment



Types of Internships

- Paid, for credit, or for experience
- Know the credit requirements and tuition implications



Timing and Deadlines

- Internships are posted year-round, but most summer internships have spring deadlines
- Start checking for summer internships as early as October for competitive positions

INTERNSHIP SEASONS

Summer Internships


- Start: May/June
- Applications Open: As early as September/October, typically January/February

Fall Internships

- Start: September/October
- Applications Open: May through August

Spring Internships

- Start: January/February
- Applications Open: September through December
