

## Undergraduate Retention and Graduation Statistics

The following table displays the cumulative graduation rates from Syracuse University of students entering the S. I. Newhouse School of Public Communications at Syracuse University as first-year students from 2011 through 2016. This group is labeled the Newhouse **Initial Cohort**. Their beginning year is displayed. The Initial Cohort beginning in 2016 is the graduating class of 2020. “N/a” indicates that data is not yet available.

(Students enter internally at the beginning, middle, or end of sophomore year.) This group is labeled Newhouse **Intra-University Transfers**. Their beginning year at Syracuse University is displayed. The IUT cohort beginning in 2016 is the graduating class of 2020. “N/a” indicates that data is not yet available.
